Nordic Mountain has extended their 4- Time Group Weeknight Program to all River View School students. This program will allow us to visit Nordic Mountain four weeknights this winter and ski/snowboard at a savings of over 60% , You may bring your own equipment.

We did our best to choose four dates which hopefully accommodate most people:

If weather does not cooperate, there may be a change in these dates.
