Dear Parent/Guardian;

Our records indicate your child will be four years old on or before September 1, 2018, therefore making them eligible to participate in our 4K program. Although, it may appear early to think about the upcoming school year for your child, it is crucial that we initiate the registration process now so that we may more effectively plan for staffing and classroom needs.

We are excited to offer two 4K options and Wrap Around Care to our families:

- Tanner Early Learning Center
- New Directions Learning Community Charter School (NDLC)
- \$120 per week Wrap Around Care offered in partnership with the YMCA (A form is enclosed, if you are interested.)

The 4K program is offered Monday through Friday, with morning and afternoon sessions. The morning session is from 7:50-10:40 a.m., and the afternoon session is from 12:20-3:10 p.m.

A parent informational meeting will be held on **Thursday, January 11 from 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. in the Tanner gym**. This will be the opportunity for families to learn more about the wonderful elementary learning opportunities that the Kaukauna Area School District has to offer. There will be a brief presentation that will highlight the similarities and differences between each school followed by rotations to learn more about elementary options. This presentation will allow parents to understand the schools, and what they have to offer for not only 4K, but beyond. Prior to the start of school, a Parent Orientation meeting will be held at the school in which your child is registered. There will also be an opportunity for you and your child to visit the school together. During the visits, 4K teachers will share specific details of what your child's 4K day will look like.

Enclosed are a series of forms that will need to be completed and **returned to the Tanner School office by February 2, 2018 to register your child for 4K**. If you choose not to have your child attend our program, please return the green registration form indicating your child will not attend. Forms included are:

1. 4K Registration Form (Green)
2. Student Registration Information (Blue)
3. Household Information (Tan)
4. Student Home Language Survey (Green)
5. Internet Access/Directory Information Withdrawal (White)
6. YMCA Wrap Around Care Registration form – if interested (White)

7. Birth Certificate – State law requires that you show proof of your child’s birth date. Please bring your child’s true certified birth certificate (with the raised seal) when returning the registration papers. Upon immediate verification the birth certificate will be returned to you.

Eligibility for free bussing is determined by the student’s home address. Tanner 4K students have access to transportation if they reside more than .5 miles from school. NDLC 4K students would have bussing available if they live within the Electa Quinney attendance area and are more than .5 miles from school. Specific bussing information will be collected this summer. The transportation policy is currently under review and may change for the 2018-2019 school year. If a change occurs, the decision will be made in early summer.

The district will be offering a developmental screening for all children who will be eligible for 4K next year. This will be offered in the beginning of June. Participating in this screening is your choice. We will send out additional information about screening at a later date.

Please pass along information about 4K registration to parents who may be new to the school district. Parents not receiving a packet should call the Tanner Early Learning Center office at 766-6150.

Parents are encouraged to contact Mrs. Thoreson, Principal at Tanner or Mrs. Frischmann, Principal at New Directions, with any questions about the 4K program. Additionally, parents are welcome to come in and visit either school if they have an interest. We look forward to the privilege of working with you and your child.
