Resolution

Opposing Potential Legislation Regarding Guns on School Grounds

Whereas, The Kaukauna Area School District (KASD) is committed to providing safe learning and working environments for all students, staff, parents, visitors, and volunteers;

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 948.605 prohibits any individual from possessing a firearm in a “school zone,” which is defined as “In or on the grounds of a school; and within 1,000 feet from the grounds of a school;”

Whereas, The KASD looks to their first responders to address safety and security concerns, and believes if persons other than sworn law enforcement officers are armed in a school or on school grounds, this would jeopardize the lives of first responders, students, staff, parents, visitors, and volunteers;

Whereas, The KASD **does permit** a firearm in the possession of and under the control of law enforcement or military personnel acting in their official capacity to be in school buildings and other buildings owned, occupied or controlled by the School District, on school premises, in school-provided transportation, or at any school-sponsored or school-supervised activity;

Whereas, The KASD does **permit** a firearm in the possession of and under the control of off-duty law enforcement personnel to be in school buildings and other buildings owned, occupied or controlled by the School District, on school premises, in school-provided transportation, or at any school-sponsored or school-supervised activity;

Whereas, The KASD **does not permit**, individuals with a Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW) license/permit, to use or possess a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded, in school buildings and other buildings owned, occupied, or controlled by the School District, on school premises, in school-provided transportation, or at any school-sponsored or school-supervised activity;

Therefore Be It Resolved the KASD Board of Education opposes legislation at the State or Federal level that would legalize any further ability for anyone to bring a firearm or possess a firearm, concealed or otherwise, in school buildings and other buildings owned, occupied, or controlled by the School District, on school premises, in school-provided transportation, or at any school-sponsored or school-supervised activity.
