### 3 Step Response To Bullying



Within PBIS  
(Positive Behavior  
Intervention and Support)

A bullying prevention strategy in PBIS teaches students a 3 step response to disrespectful behavior that **empowers** them to defuse the situation themselves.



***Stop/Walk/and Talk is a phrase to help students***

***remember the***

**3 Steps**

***Stop/Walk/and Talk***



## Stop

The student says “stop” and uses a hand gesture (hand held up) and an I - message when they experience disrespectful behavior.



## Walk

The student walks away from disrespectful behavior if it continues.

## Talk

The student tells an adult about the disrespectful behavior if it continues.



- Students who use Stop/Walk/Talk plan learn how to respond appropriately to bully behavior.
