**INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$32,930,000**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Kaukauna Area School District, Outagamie, Calumet and Brown Counties, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$32,930,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of District-wide safety and security improvements; instructional space renovations to the the District's four elementary school buildings; instructional space renovations to River View Middle School as well as the addition of a multi-purpose space/gymnasium; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a Notice to Electors (in substantially the form attached hereto as Attachment One) in the Times-Villager, within ten (10) days of the adoption of the foregoing resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 67.05(6a)(a)2.a. of the Wisconsin Statutes, the District Clerk is hereby directed to submit the foregoing Initial Resolution to the electors for approval or rejection at the April 2, 2019 election. The Initial Resolution shall not be effective unless adopted by a majority of the school district electors voting at the referendum.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$5,800,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Kaukauna Area School District, Outagamie, Calumet and Brown Counties, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,800,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing and equipping a multi-purpose space/gymnasium addition to River View Middle School.
