Calculus requires the TI-89 Graphing Calculator;
All other math classes require the TI-30XIIS calculator.

Physical Education

Science

Biology: Composition book (wide rule, 9 3/4" x 7 1/2"), calculator, whiteboard marker
Chemistry, Accelerated Chemistry & Advanced Chemistry: Scientific calculator, whiteboard marker, and a notebook.
Life Science & Anatomy and Physiology: 2" three ring binder, binder dividers, loose leaf paper and colored pencils or pens, whiteboard marker.
